

What is Christian Legal Aid?

Christian Legal Aid is a pro-bono clinic that provides qualifying individuals with free legal advice.

Where is the clinic located?

Clinics are held at the Allegheny Center Alliance Church, 250 E Ohio Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15212. All clinics are held in the Union Place Building.

When are clinics held?

Clinics are held every Monday evening from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm. All walk-ins are assisted on a first come, first served basis, so we advise you to arrive at the clinic early.

Will I see an attorney the first time I attend clinic?

You will not see an attorney the first time you attend clinic. During your first visit, you will complete an intake, and, after the intake, you will be scheduled for an appointment with the attorney.

How do I know whether I qualify for Christian Legal Aid?

We can assist individuals who meet the following requirements:

- The individual is seeking advice for a civil legal matter;
- The individual resides in Allegheny County or has a legal matter in Allegheny County;
- The individual earns up to or less than 250 percent of the Federal Poverty Guideline.
